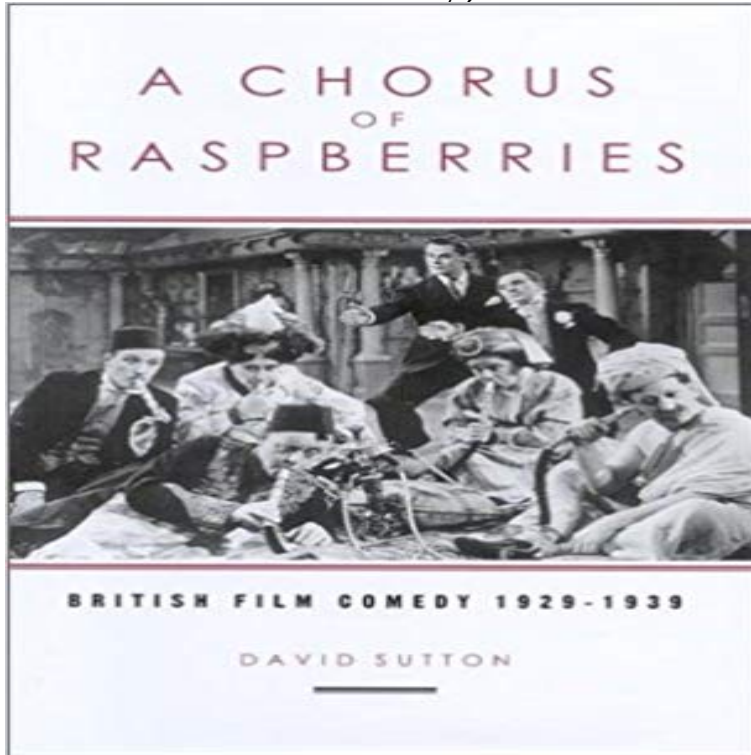


## A Chorus Of Raspberries: British Film Comedy 1929-1939 (Exeter Studies in Film History)
