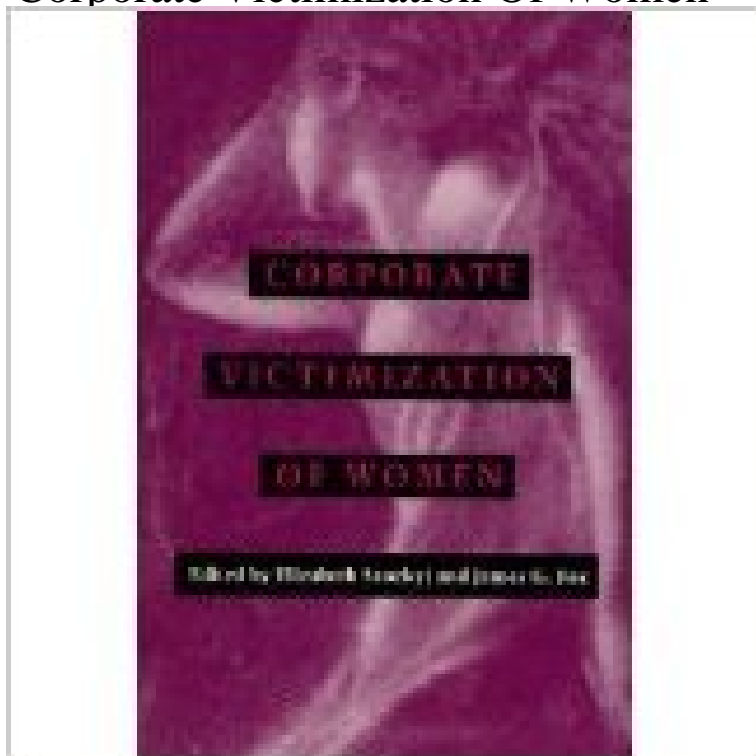


Corporate Victimization Of Women
