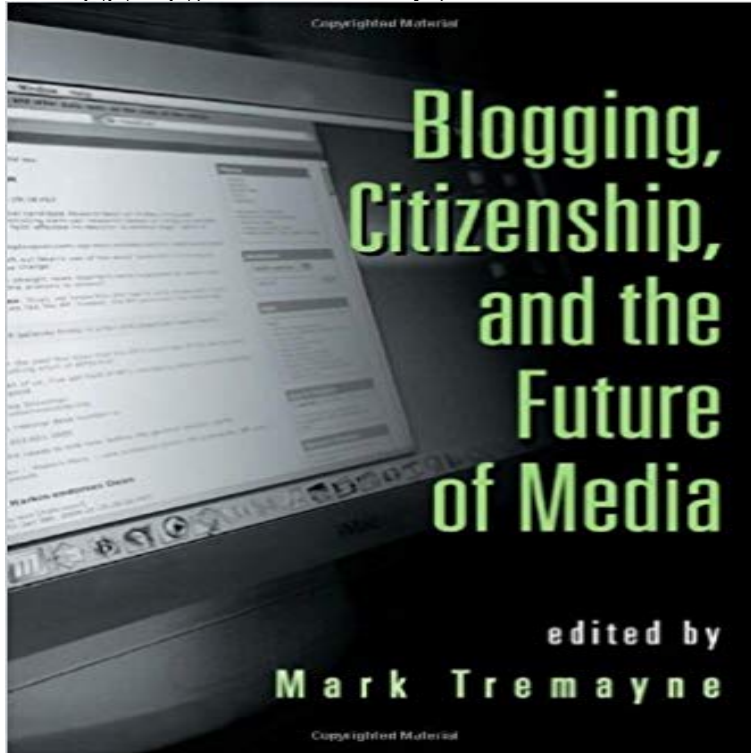


Blogging, Citizenship, and the Future of Media
