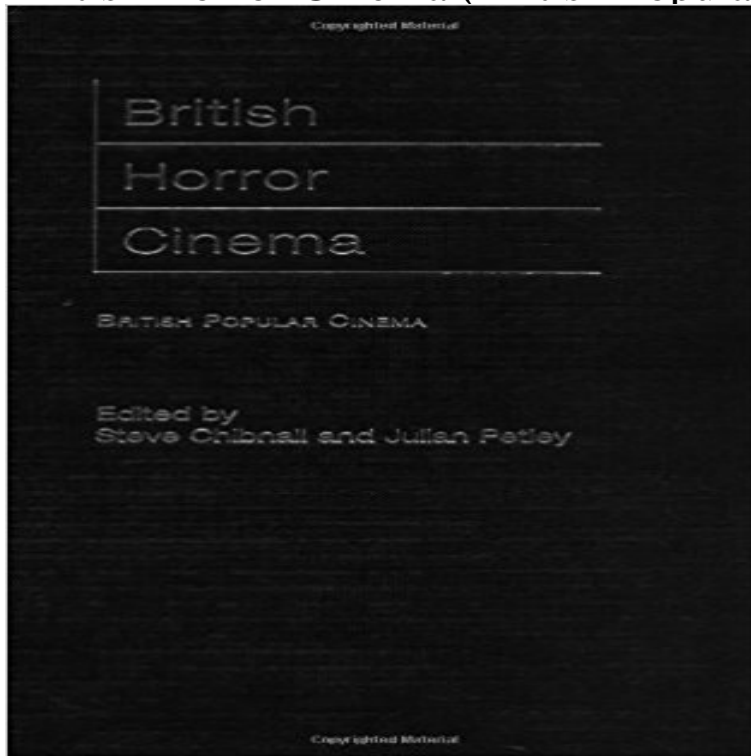


British Horror Cinema (British Popular Cinema)
