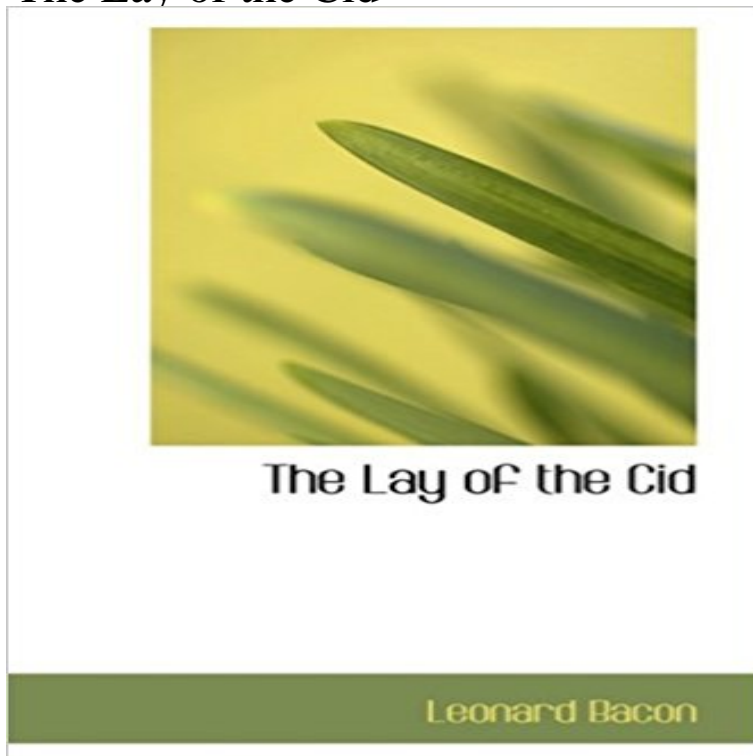


The Lay of the Cid
