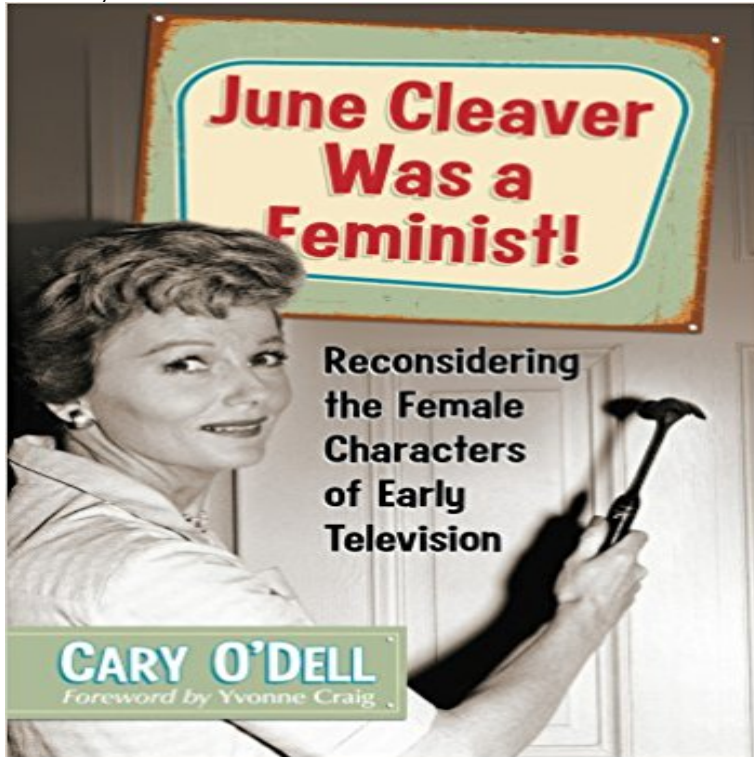


June Cleaver Was a Feminist!: Reconsidering the Female Characters of Early Television
