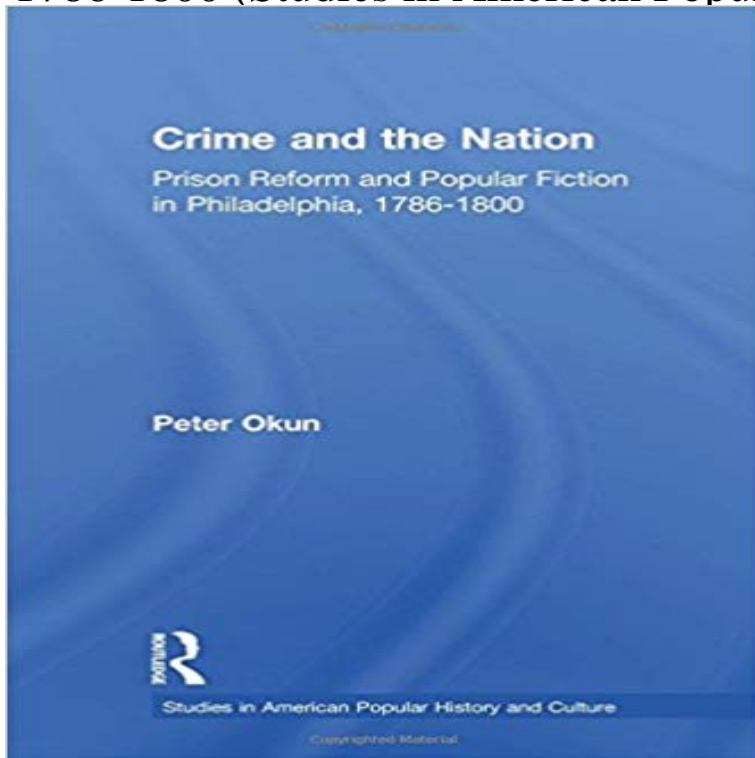


# Crime and the Nation: Prison and Popular Fiction in Philadelphia, 1786-1800 (Studies in American Popular History and Culture)

In a young nation whose very origins were perceived as criminal, yet clearly necessary and ultimately redeemable, crime emerged as an essential-and controversial-component of national identity.
