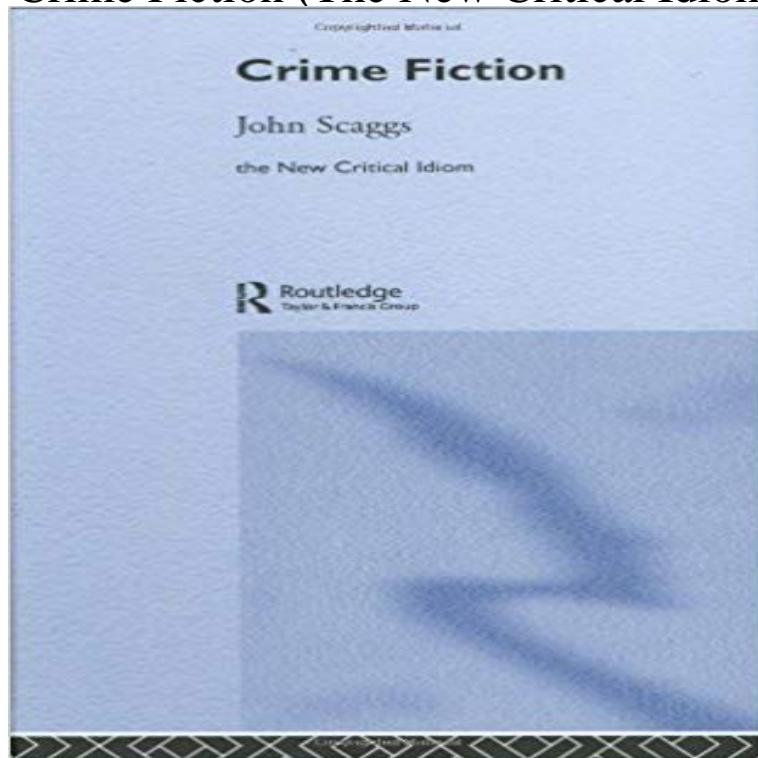


## Crime Fiction (The New Critical Idiom)
