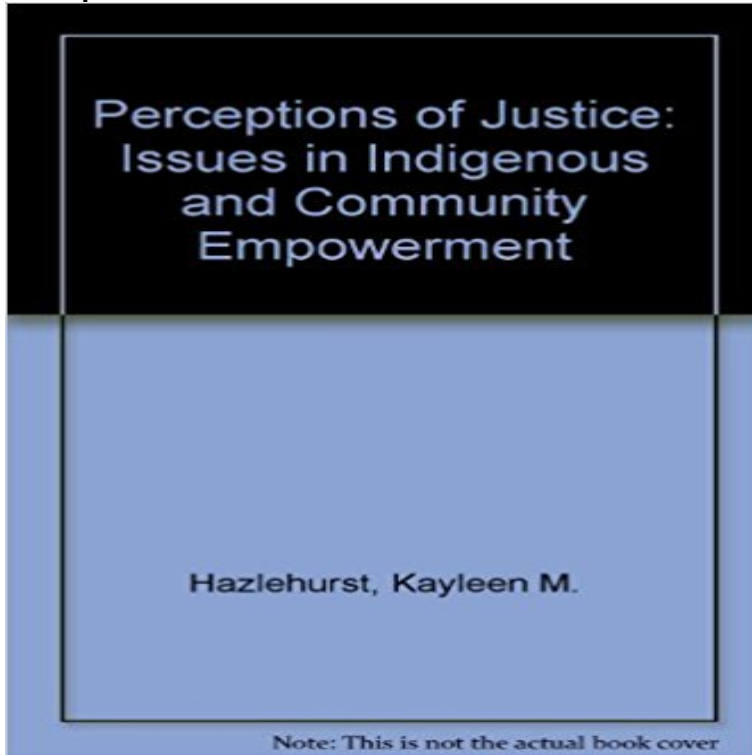


# Perceptions of Justice: Issues in Indigenous and Community Empowerment
