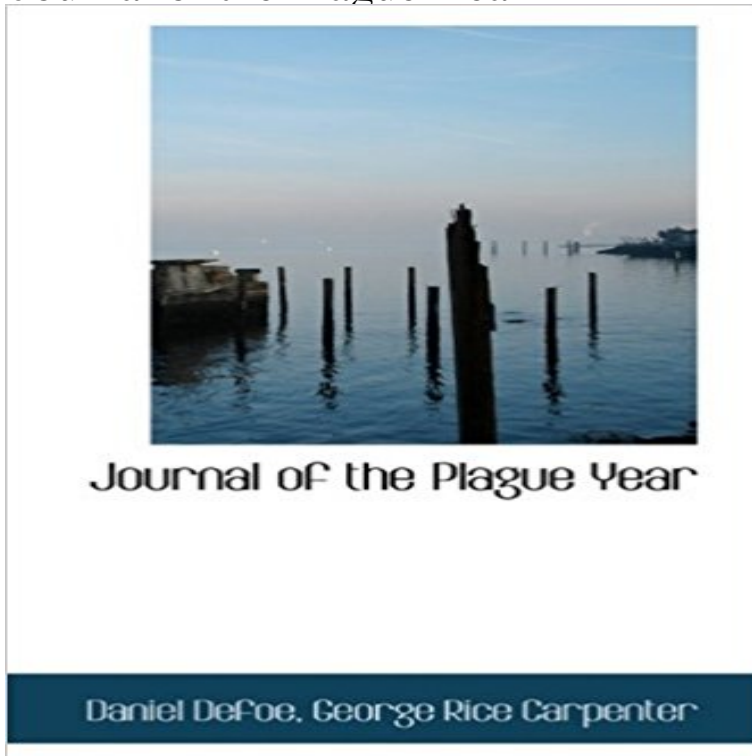


## Journal of the Plague Year
