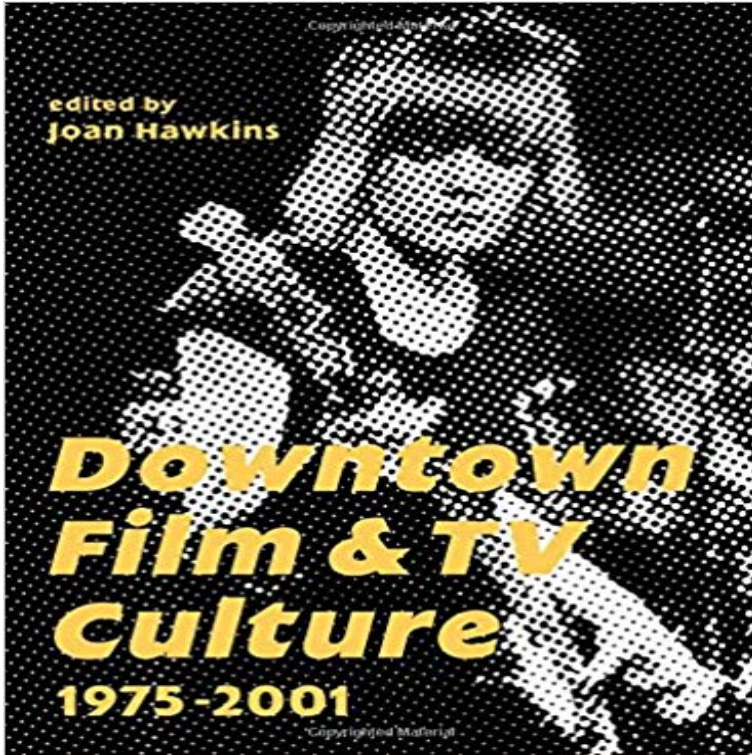


Downtown Film and TV Culture 1975-2001
