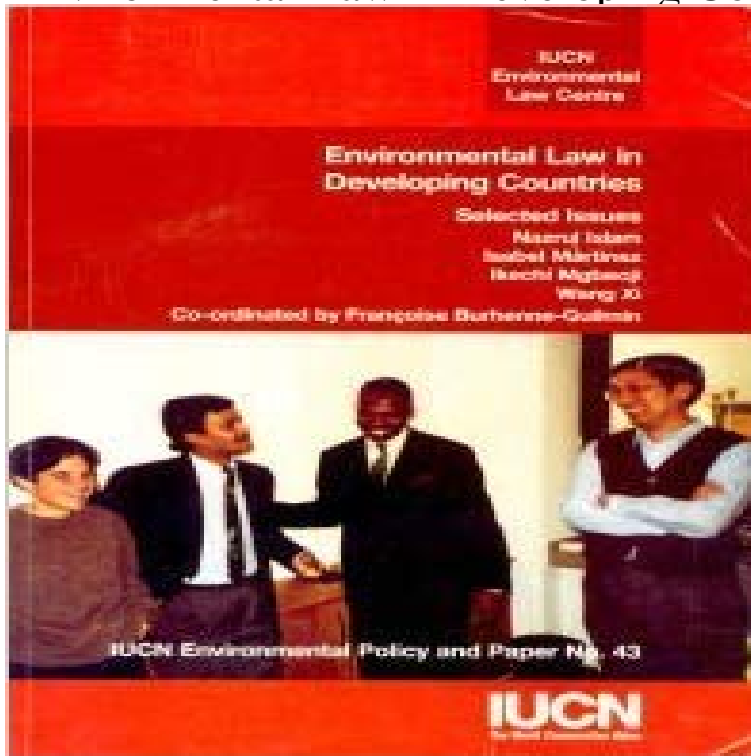


Environmental Law in Developing Countries: Volume I: Selected Issues
