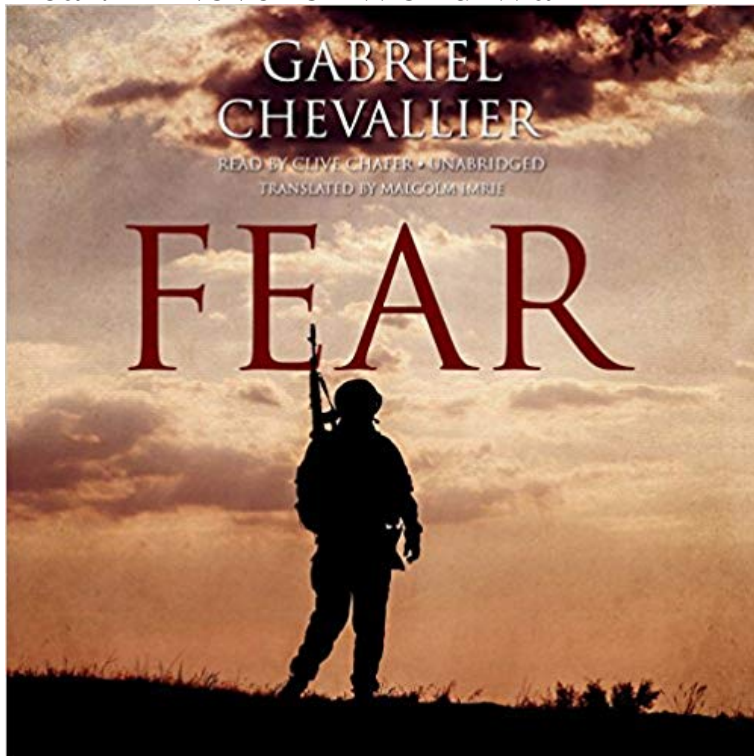


## Fear: A Novel of World War I
