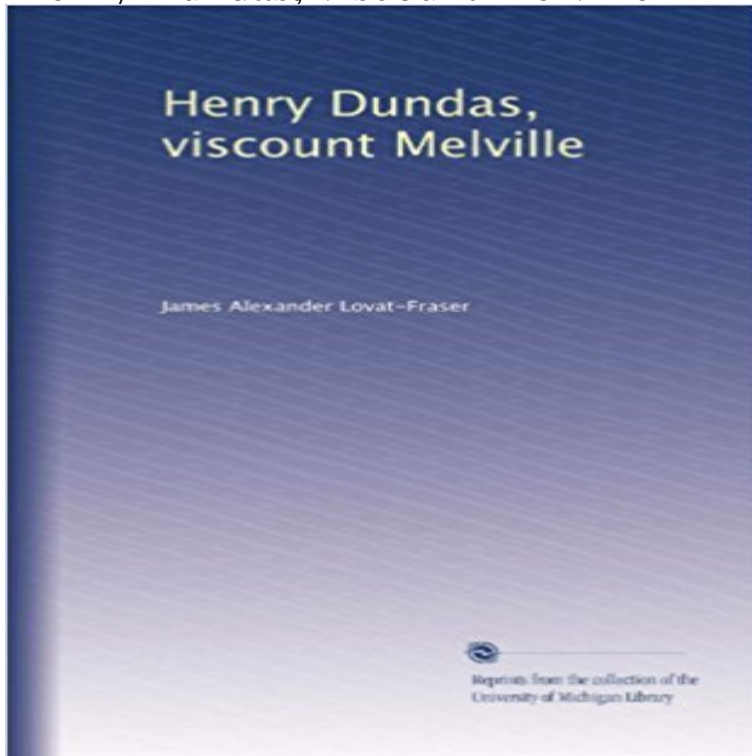


## Henry Dundas, viscount Melville
