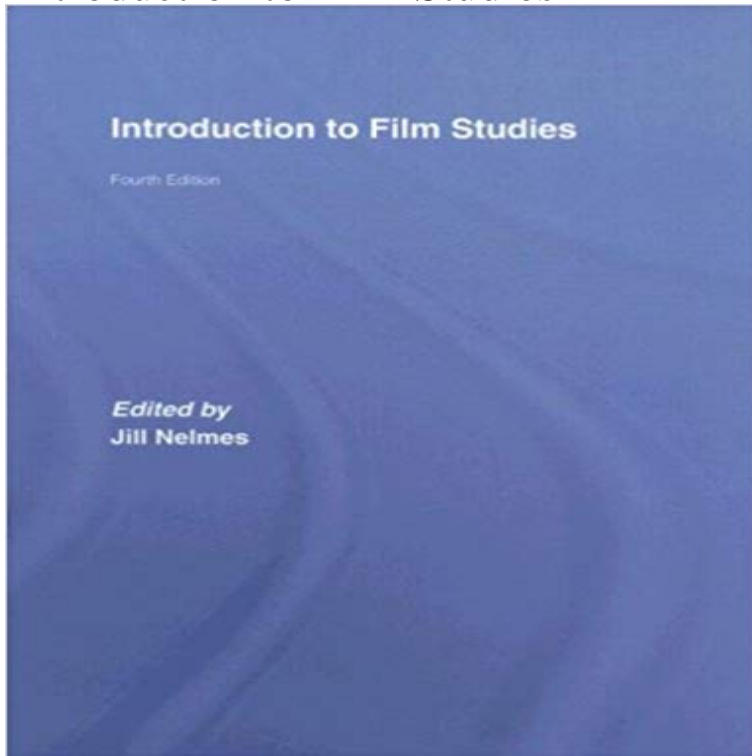


Introduction to Film Studies
