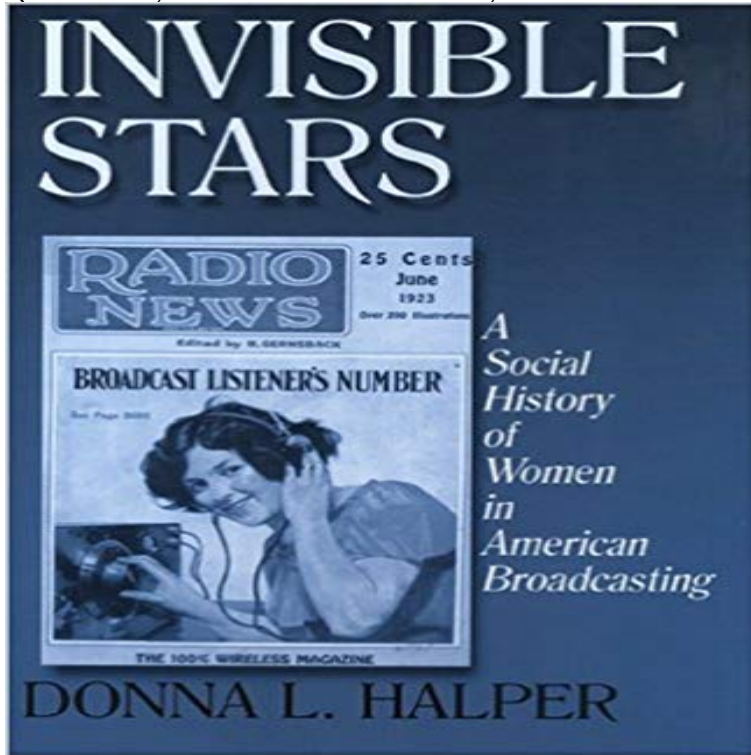


Invisible Stars: A Social History of Women in American Broadcasting (Media, Communication, and Culture in America)
