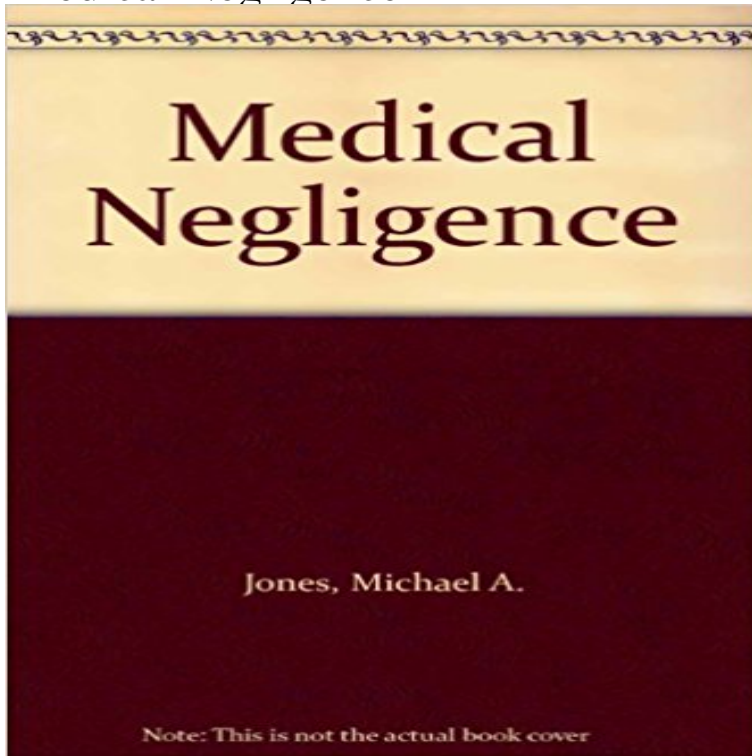


## Medical Negligence
