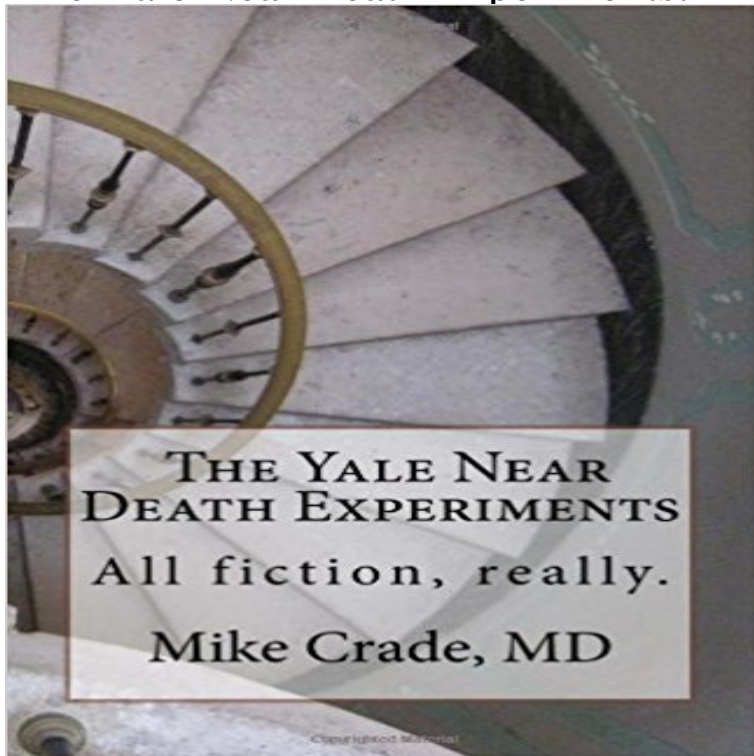


The Yale Near Death Experiments: This is all fiction, really.
