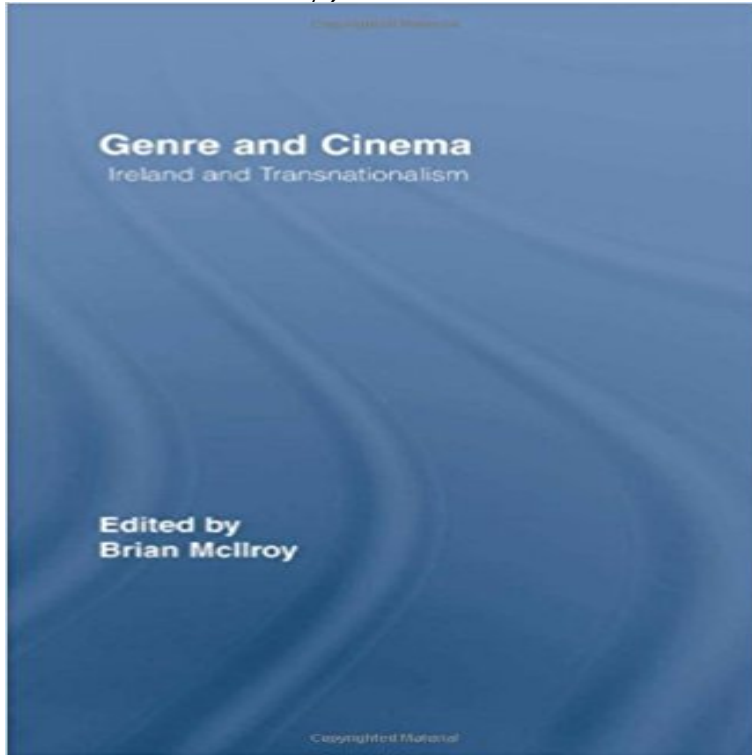


## Genre and Cinema: Ireland and Transnationalism (Routledge Studies in Cultural History)
