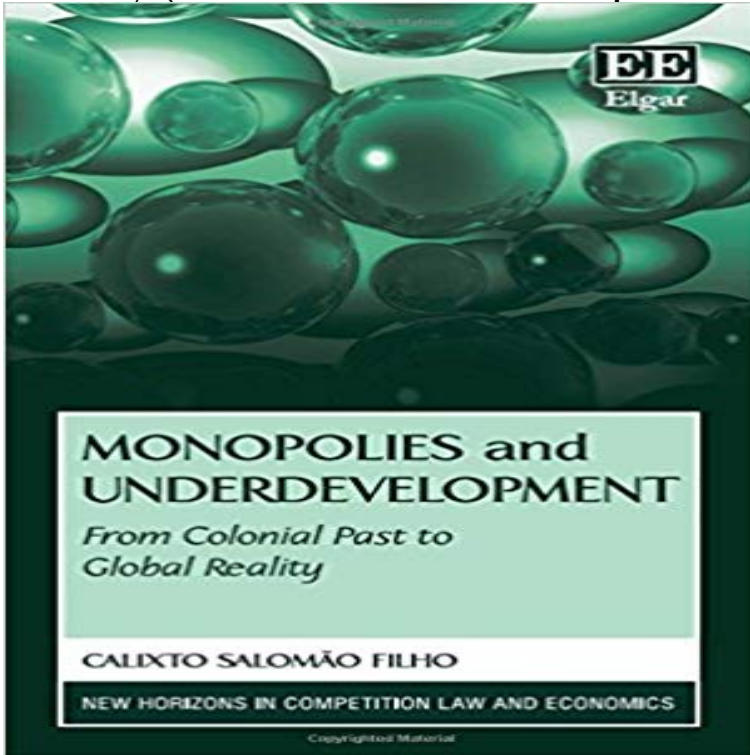


Monopolies and Underdevelopment: From Colonial Past to Global Reality (New Horizons in Competition Law and Economics series)
