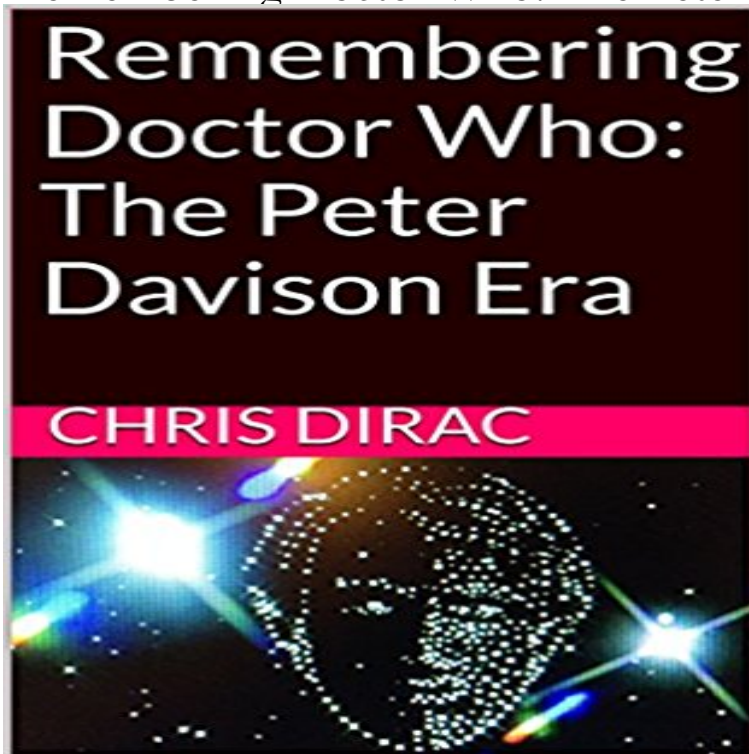


## Remembering Doctor Who: The Peter Davison Era
