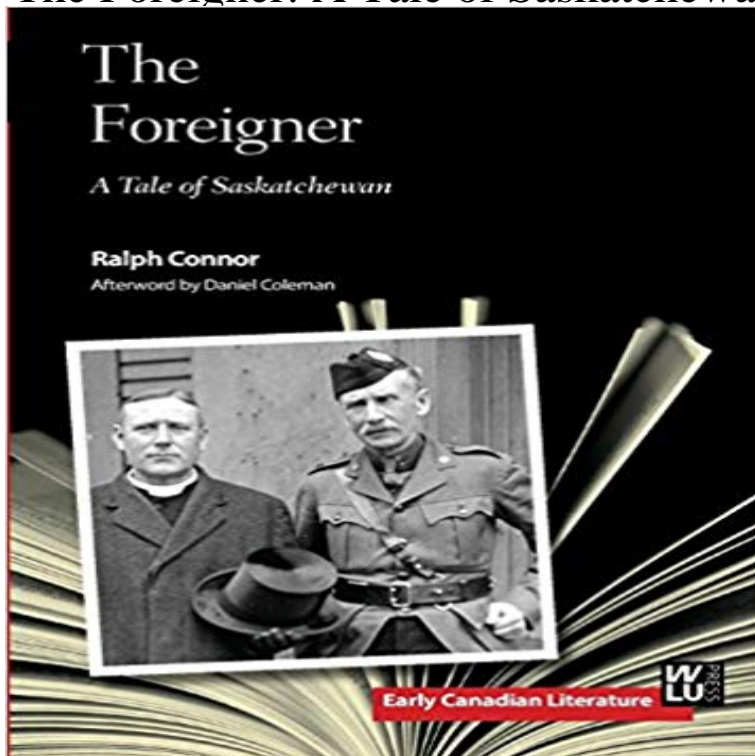


The Foreigner: A Tale of Saskatchewan (Early Canadian Literature)

Daniel Coleman's afterword considers the text's departure from Connors' established fiction formulas and provides a unique framework for understanding its depiction of difference.
