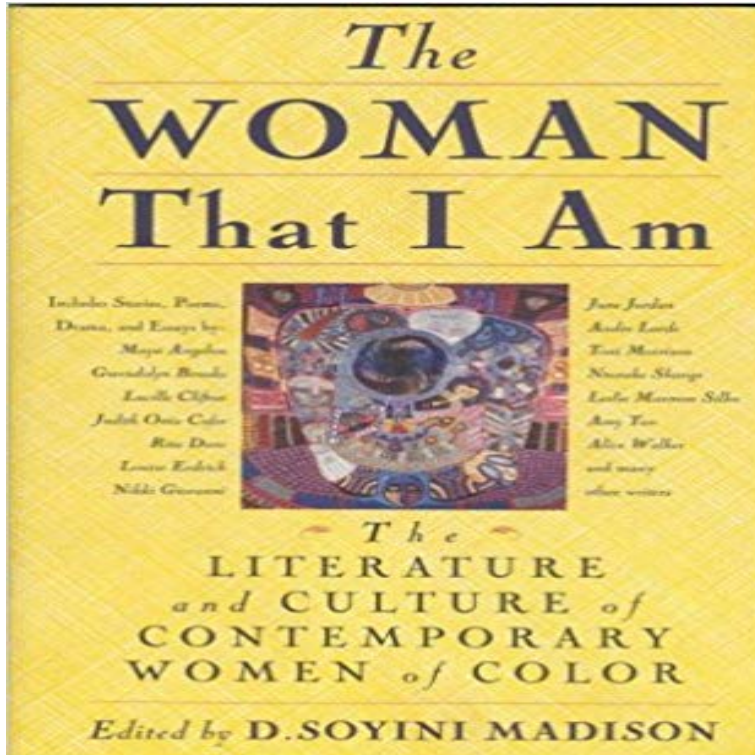


The Woman That I Am: The Literature and Culture of Contemporary Women of Color
