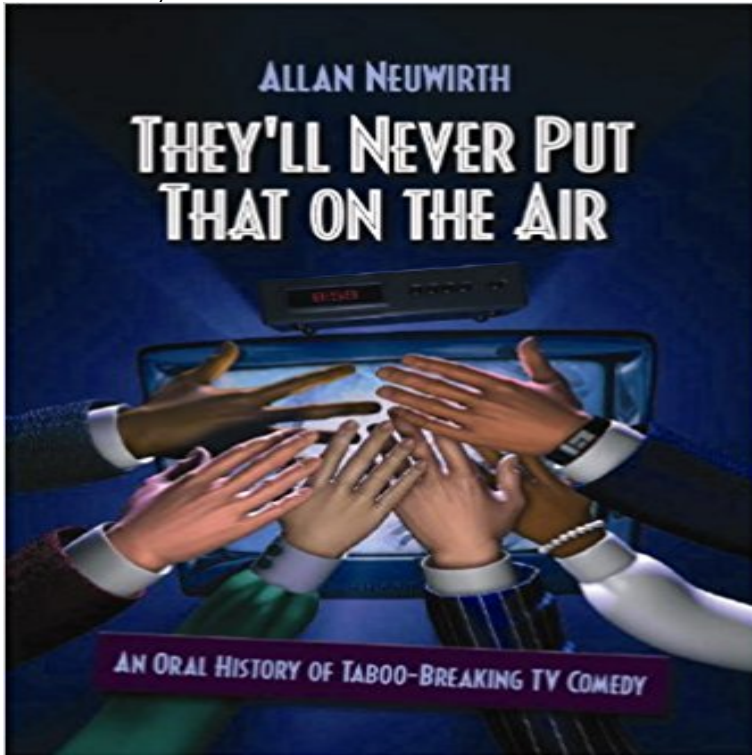


Theyll Never Put That on the Air: An Oral History of Taboo-Breaking Comedy
