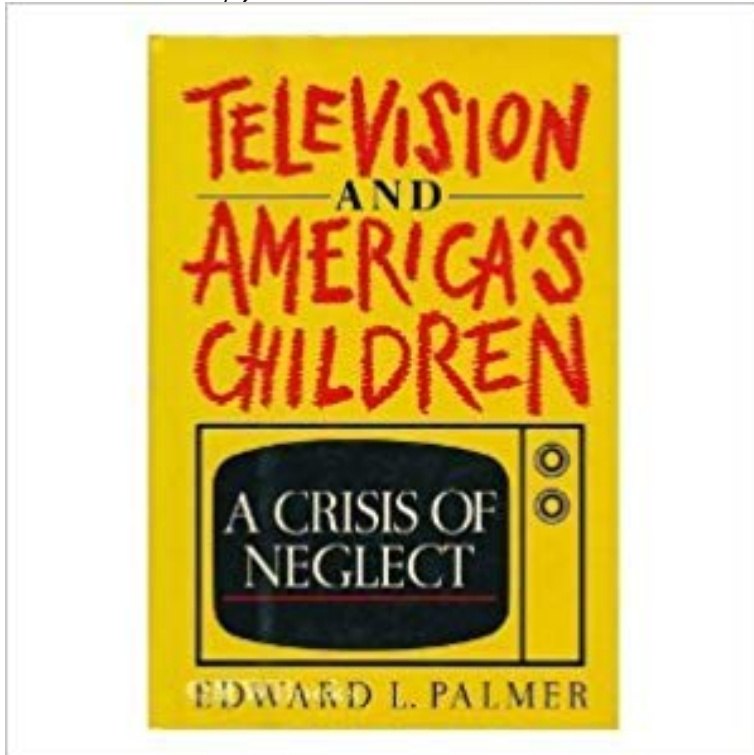


## Television and Americas Children: A Crisis of Neglect (Communication and Society)



Since the demise of Captain Kangaroo in the early eighties, the three major commercial networks have offered no regularly scheduled weekday programming for children, and American Public TV, with its chronic lack of funds, produces only about a sixth the volume of new childrens programs each year as Britains BBC or Japans NHK. Yet, as Edward Palmer reveals in this illuminating volume, America could easily have the finest childrens television in the world, for less than one cent per day for each of the nations forty-two million children. One of the founders of the Childrens Television Workshop pioneered twenty years ago, Palmer explores the reasons behind the deplorable state of U.S. childrens television and lays a large part of the blame on commercial TV, whose policy is not to serve the public, but to sell viewers to advertisers.
