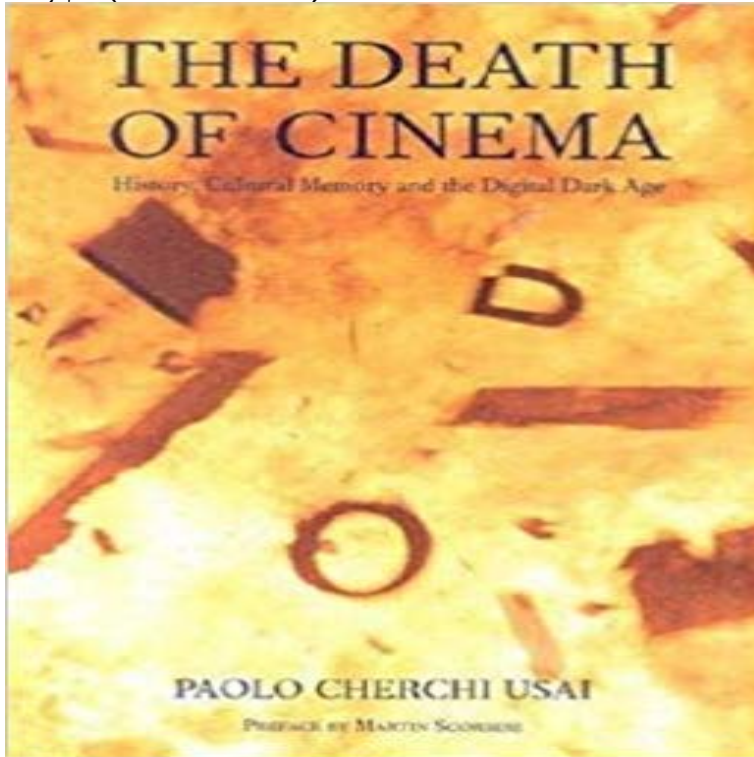


The Death of Cinema: History, Cultural Memory and the Digital Dark Age (Hardback) - Common
