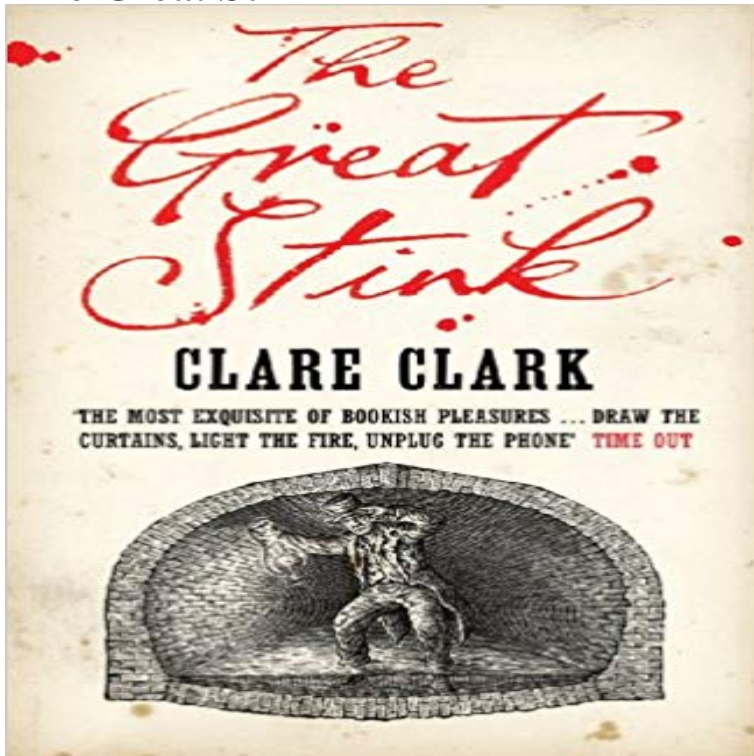


The Great Stink
