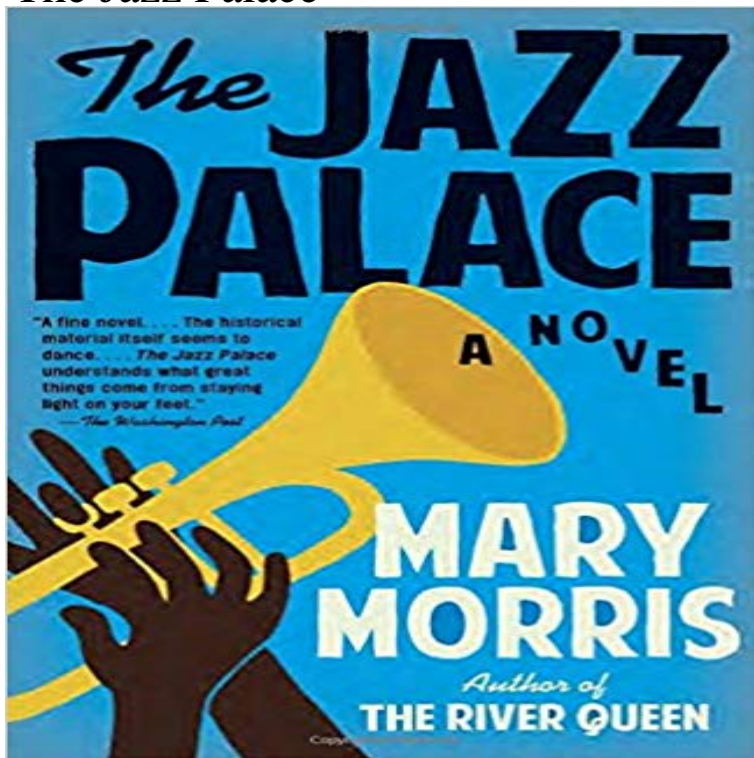


The Jazz Palace
