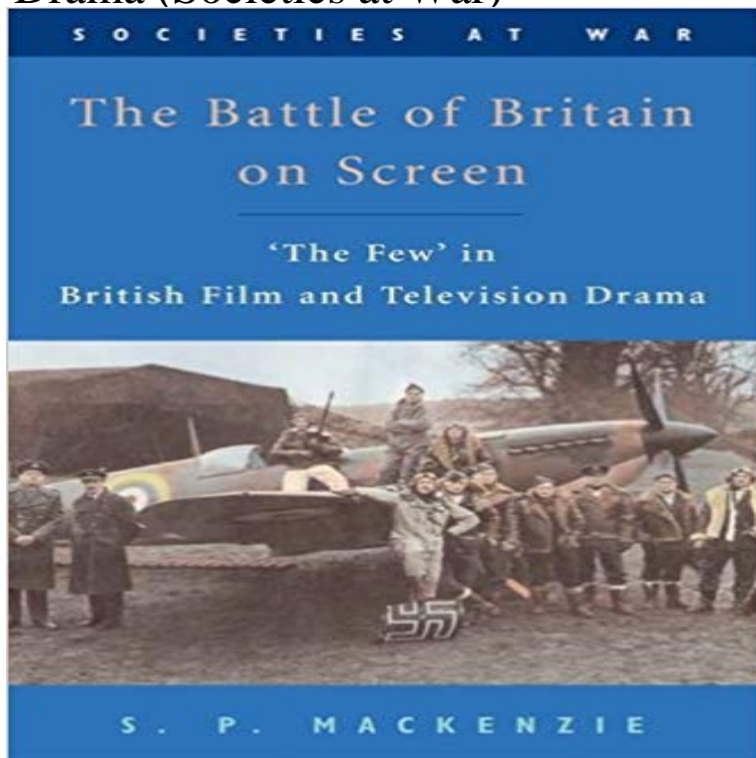


## The Battle of Britain on Screen: The Few in British Film and Television Drama (Societies at War)
