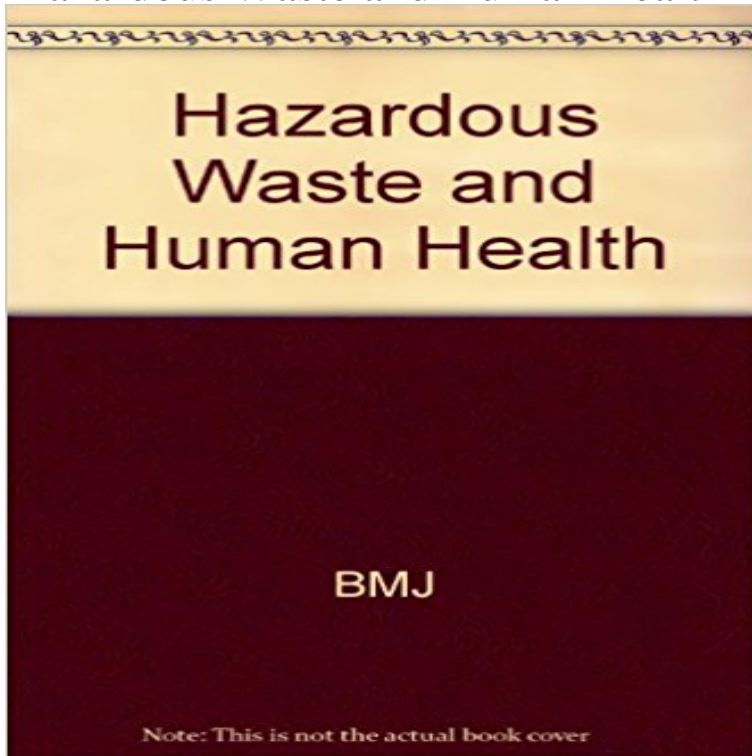


Hazardous Waste and Human Health
