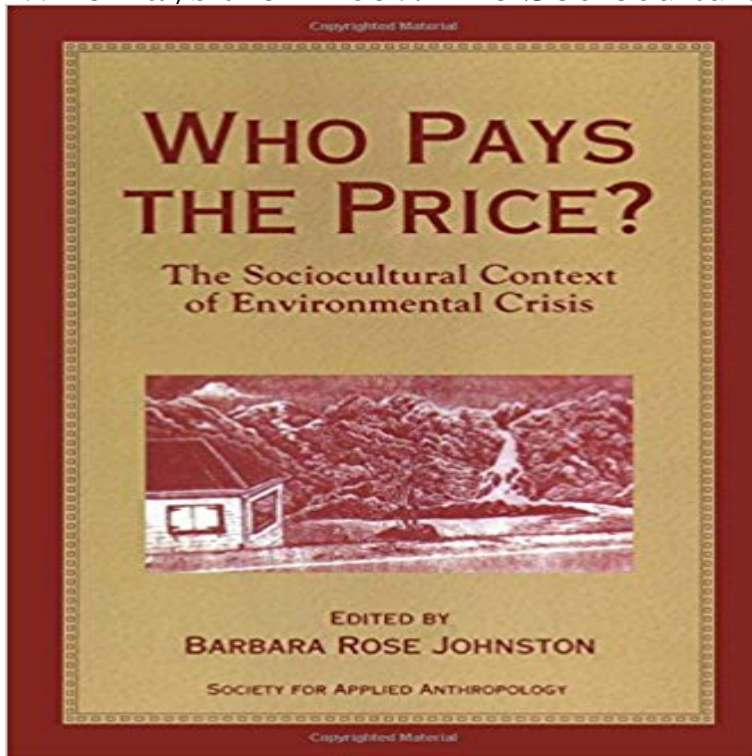


Who Pays the Price?: The Sociocultural Context Of Environmental Crisis
